Dedication

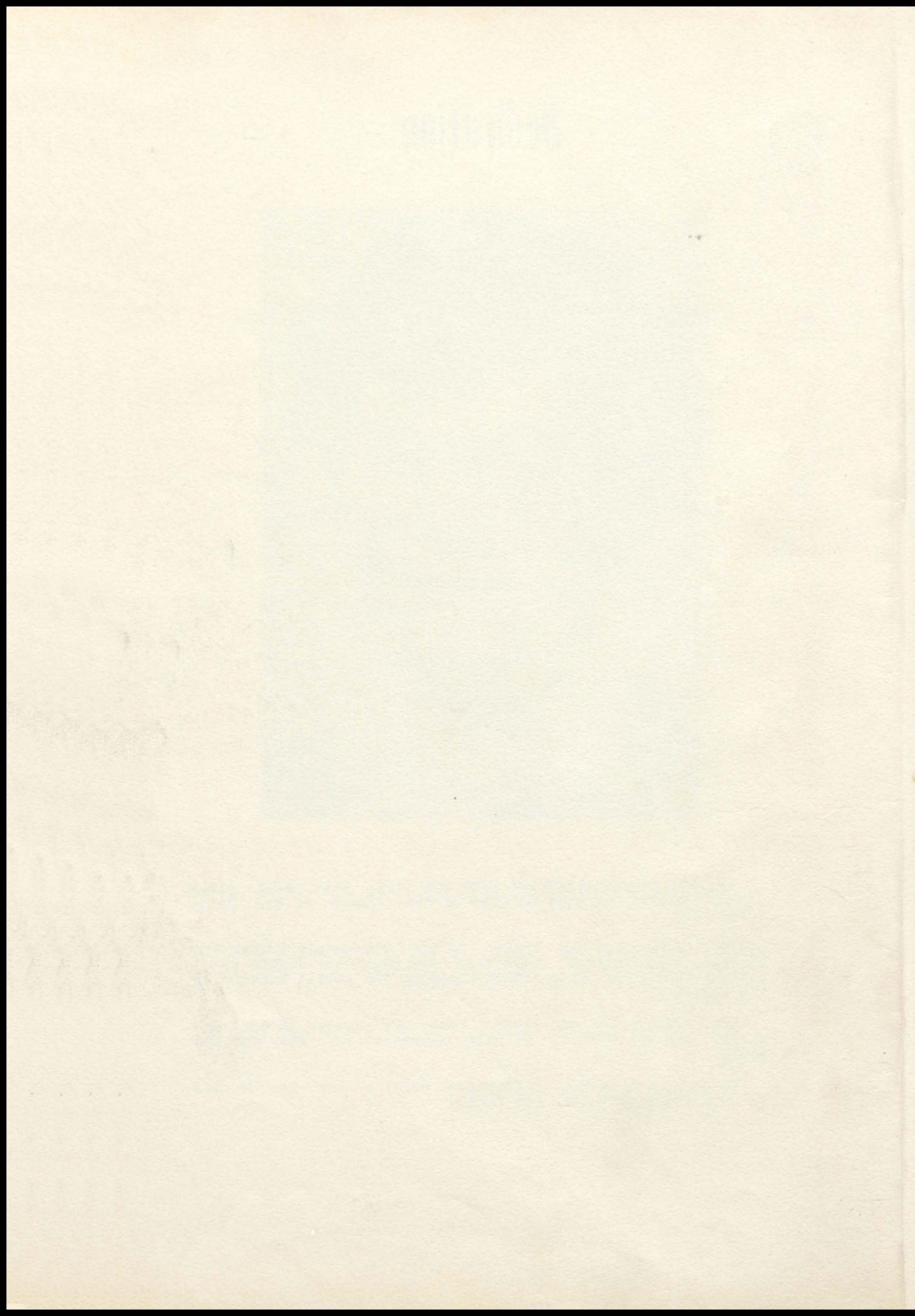


We, the annual staff of 1954 and 1955, take great pleasure in dedicating this edition of "The Tiger" to Mrs. Jania Hofmeister.

In our seventh year we lost Jack Edwards. Our teachers were Mr. George Mead, Mr. George Seeley and Mr. D. E. Davis.

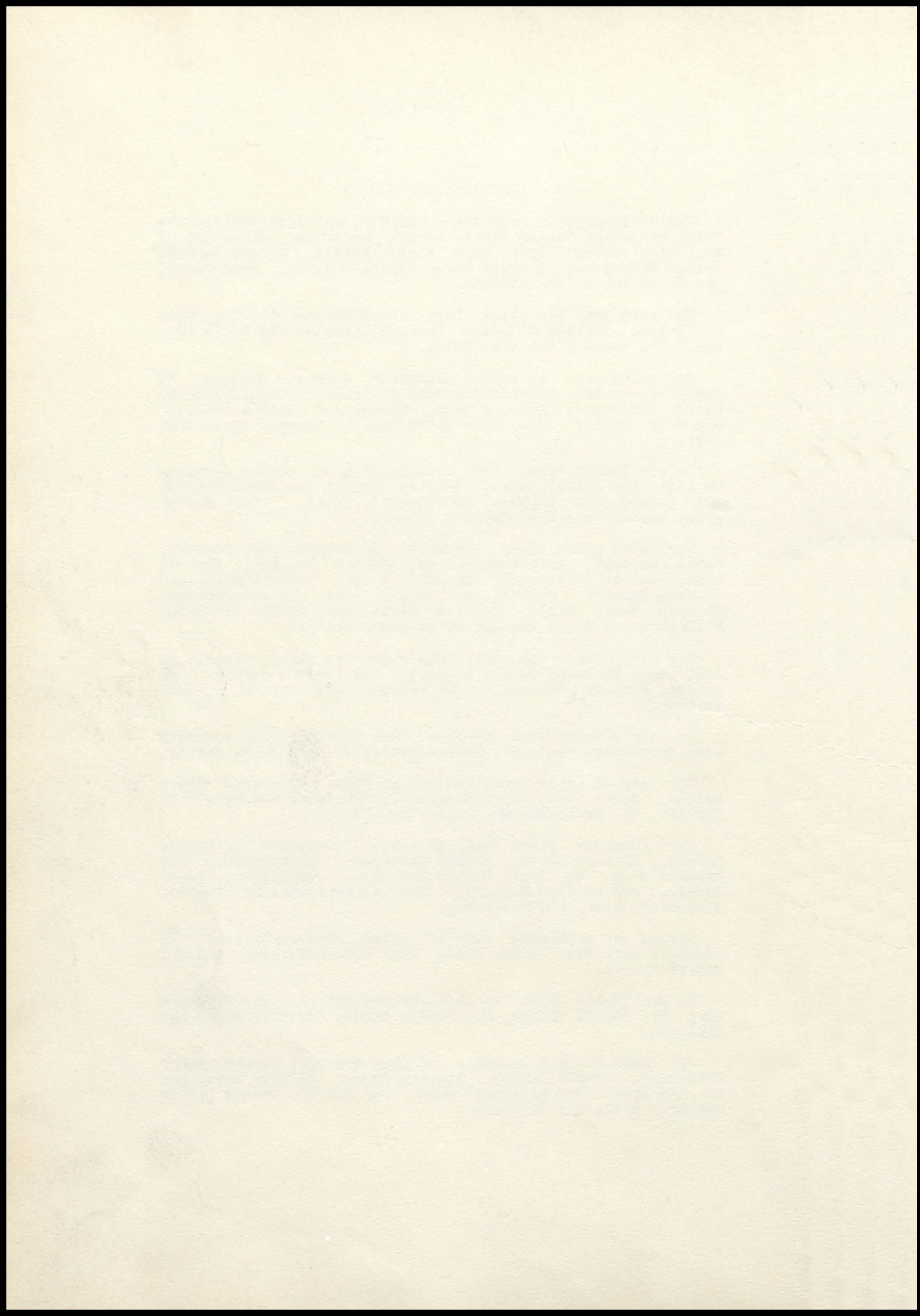

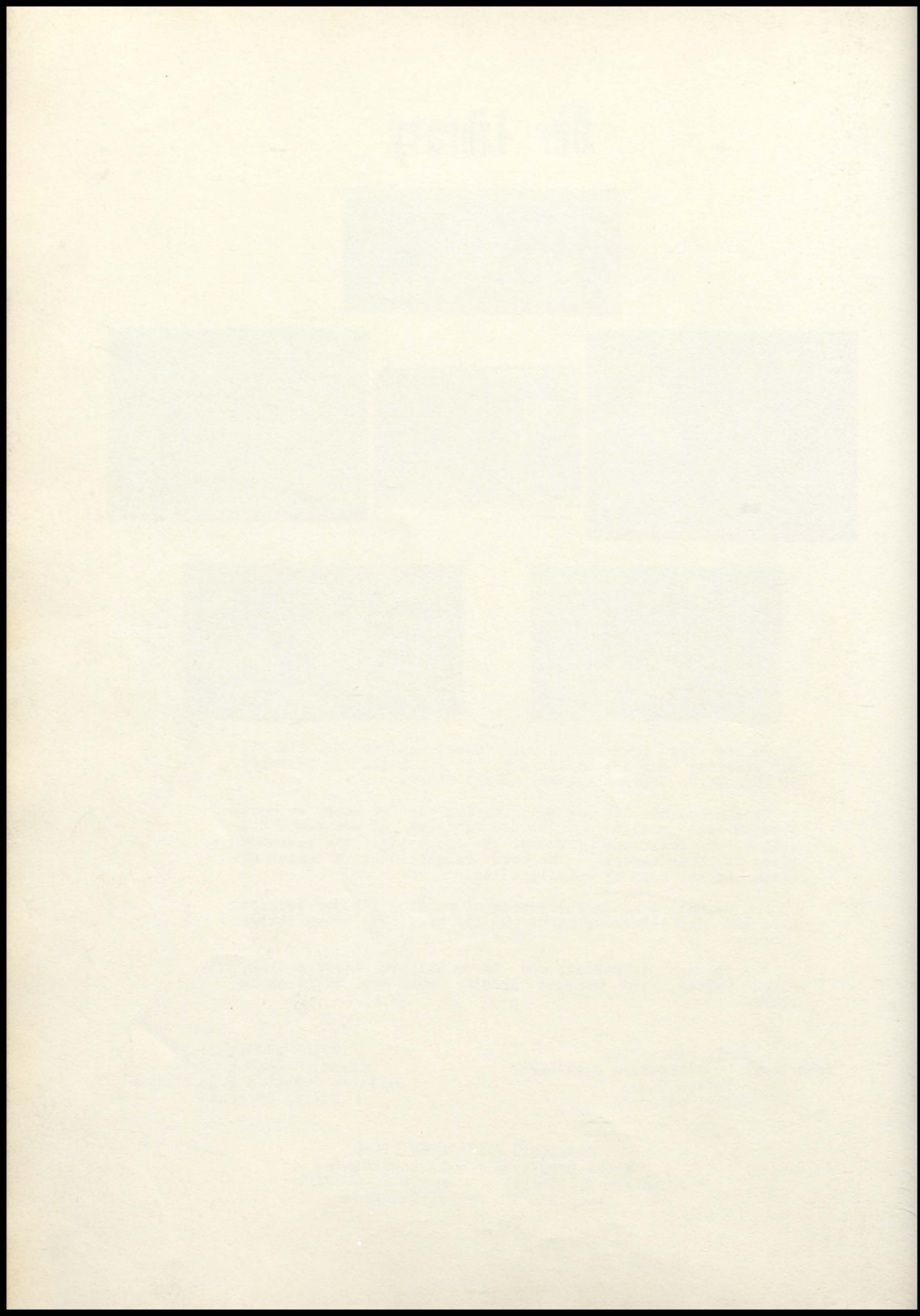
Now we have a wonderful source of reading for our leisure time and for reference work. We now have 733 books in our library.

The present librarians are Karen Reinert, Loretta Stum, Floyd Barnes, and Rebecca Brodie, with Mrs. Silliman in charge.

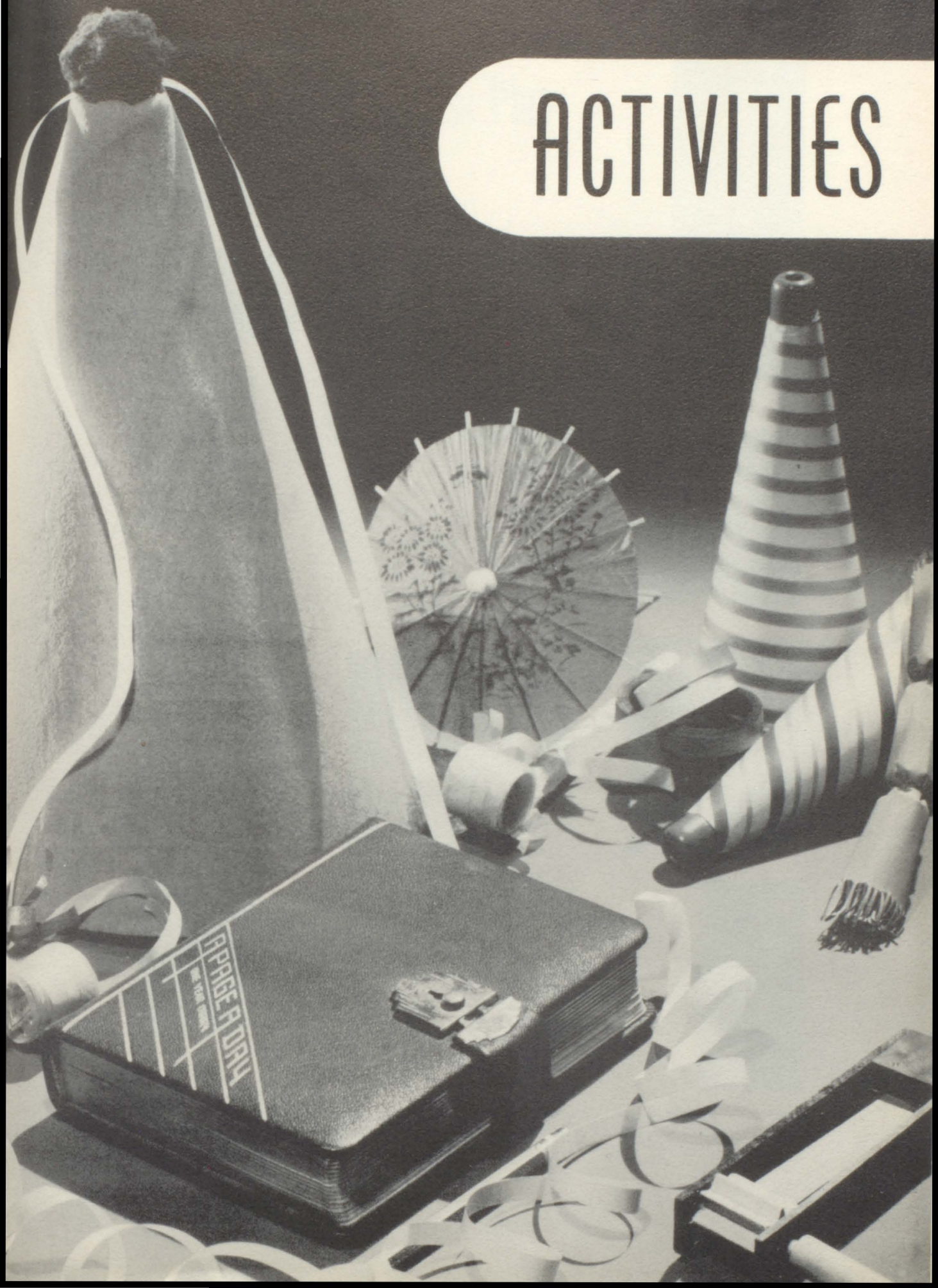
