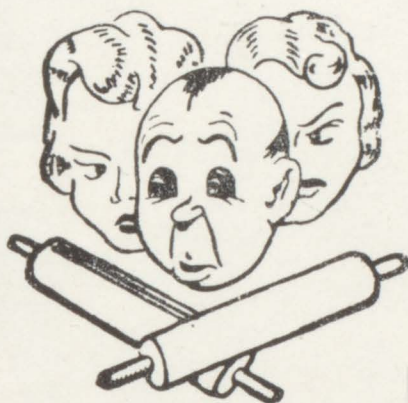

I, Rebecca Brodie, do bequeath my height to Anita Story.

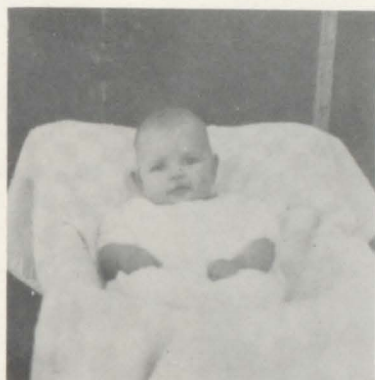
I, Lola Barnard, will my quietness to Richard Humburg so that he might have more of it.

Class Trip -- 1955-56



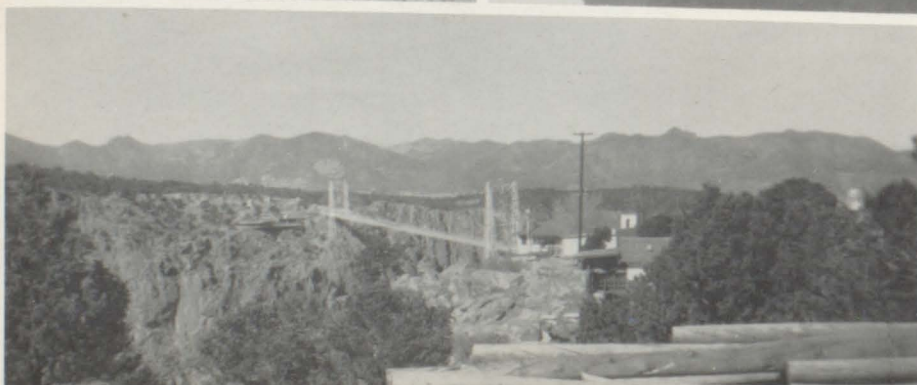
