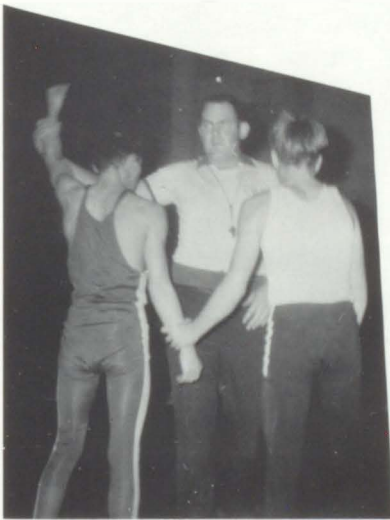




Our Team
