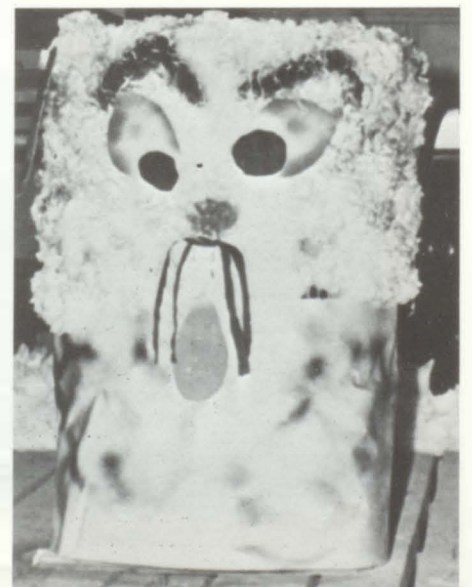




## *Coach*

Sophomores. Donnie Kelley, Donald Oswald, and Mark Forsyth show great potential for next year.

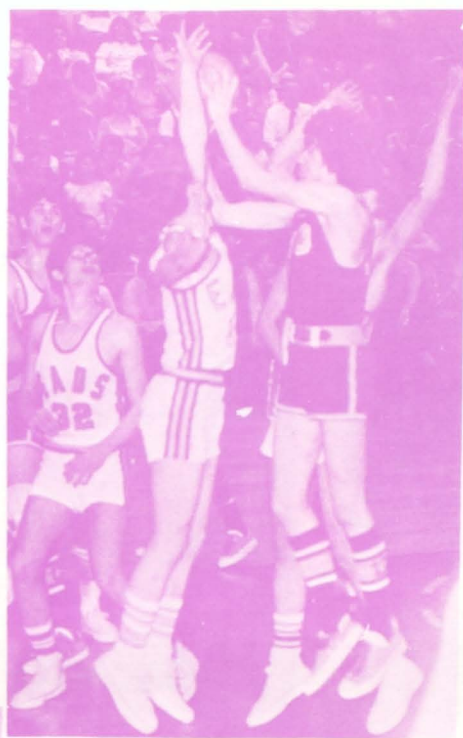
