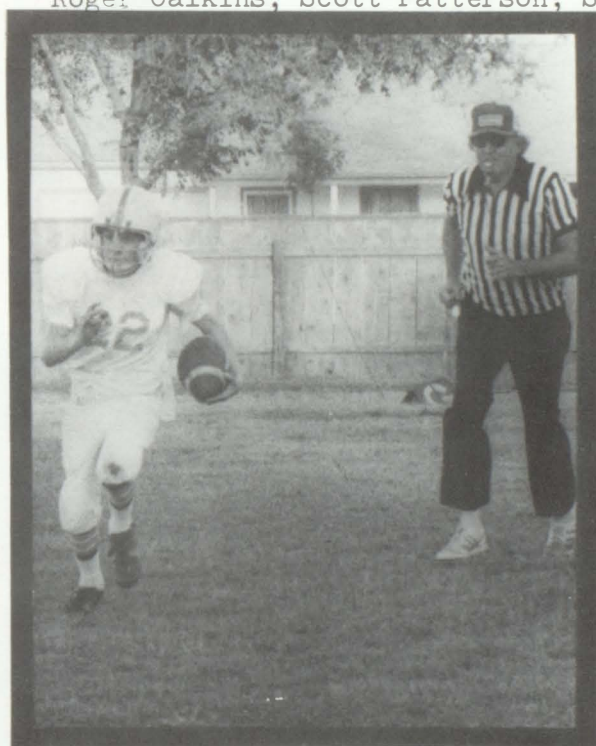

Coach's Comments

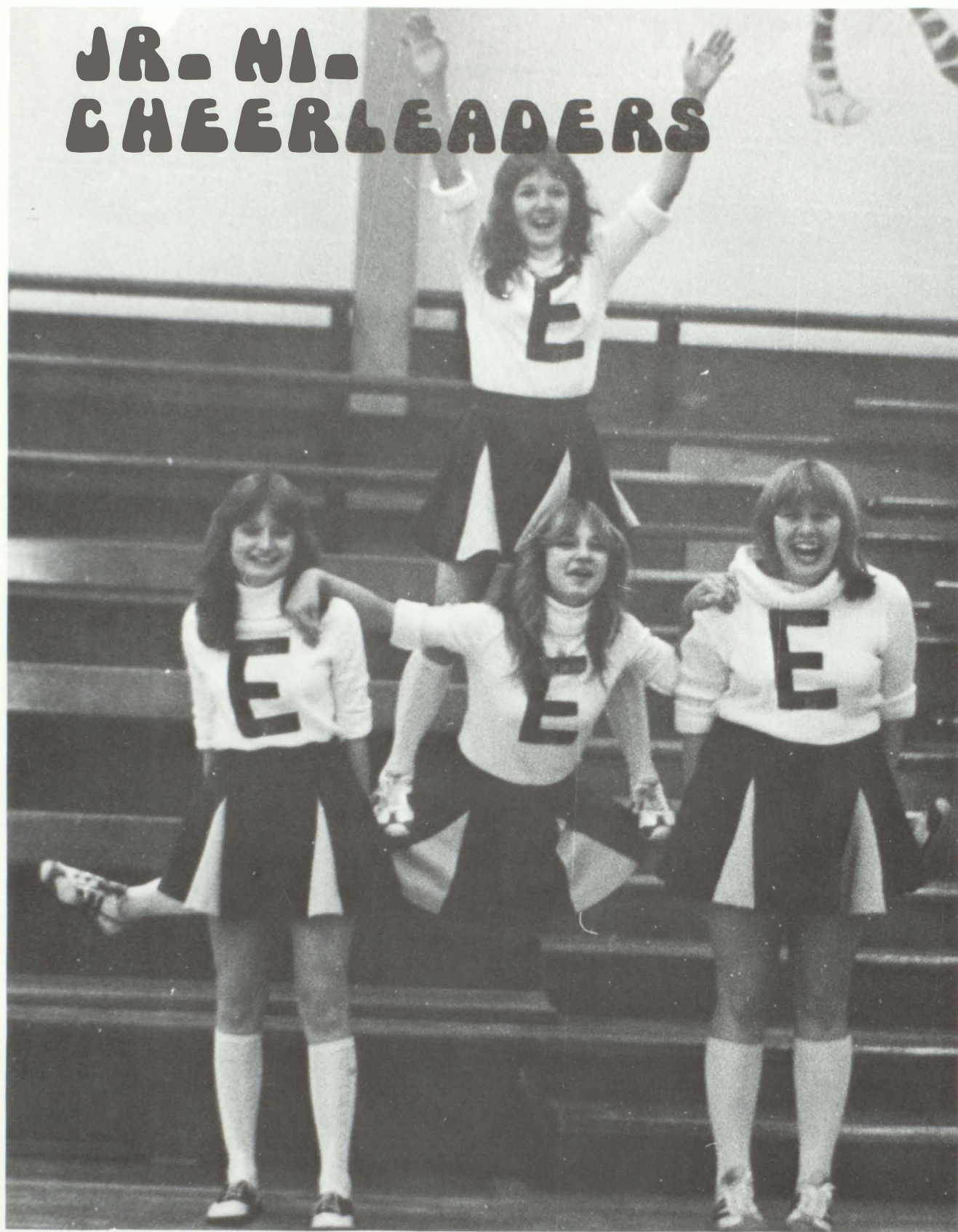
