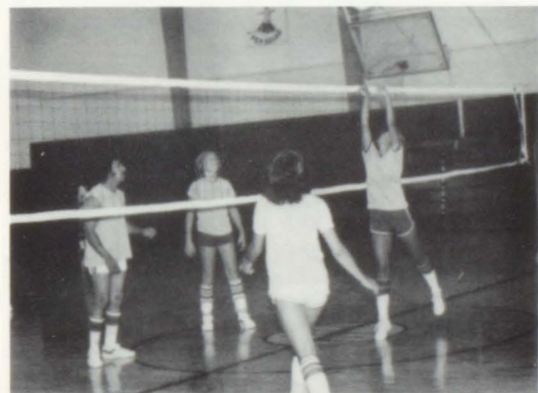

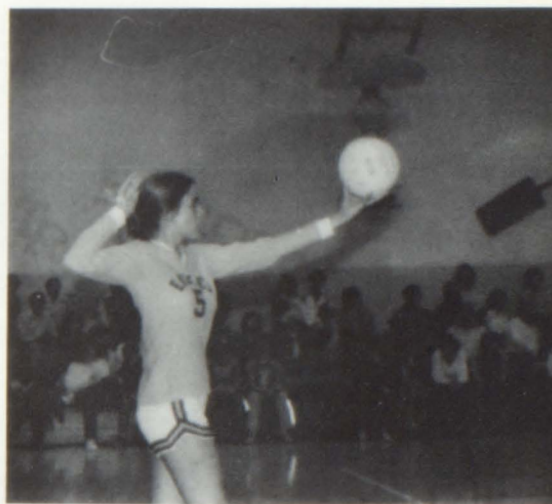

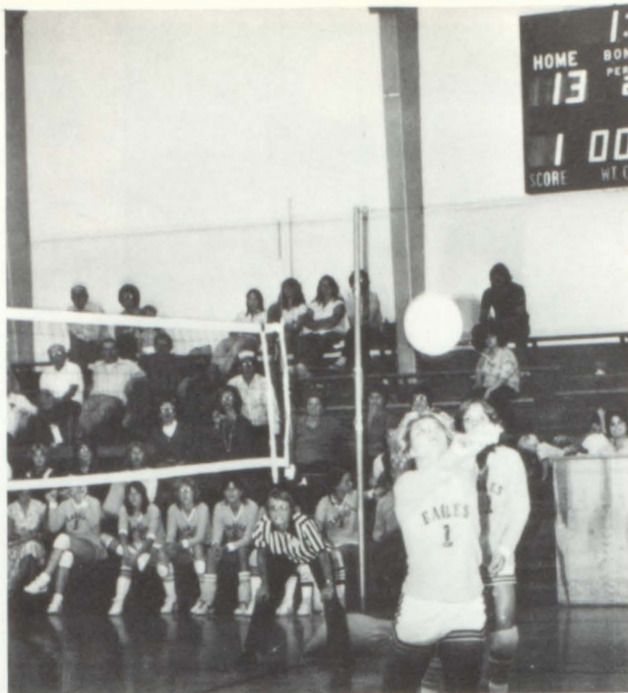

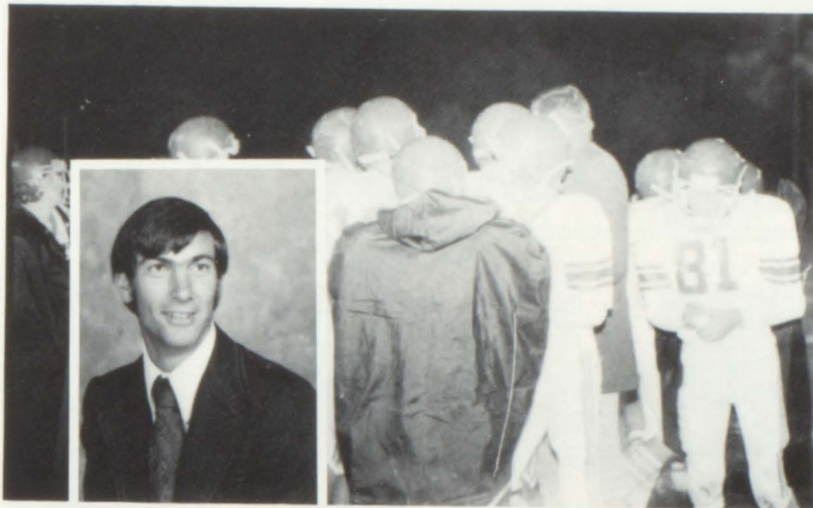

My appreciation goes to the boys, Mr. DeVaughn, the managers, and all who had a part in making the 1980 football season so successful.

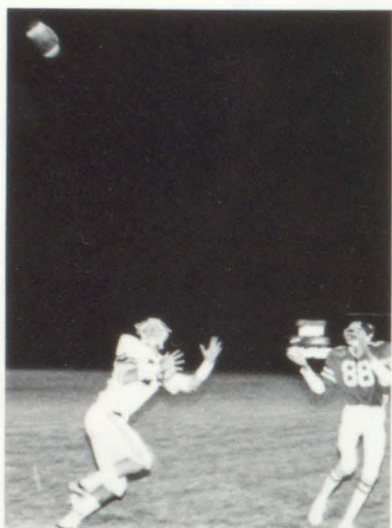
