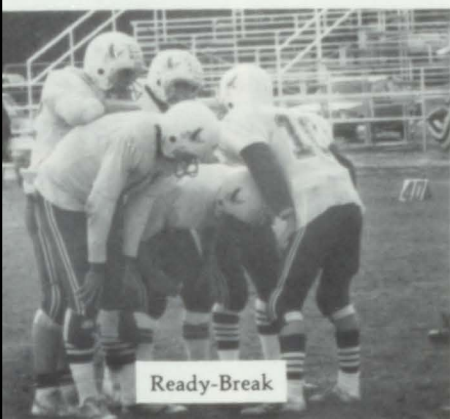
The 1984 Plainview football season turned out to be a very unfortunate one for the Hawks.

The Hawks gave the rest of the season a good fight but from a lack of experience and a lack of players the Hawks were unable to win a game.

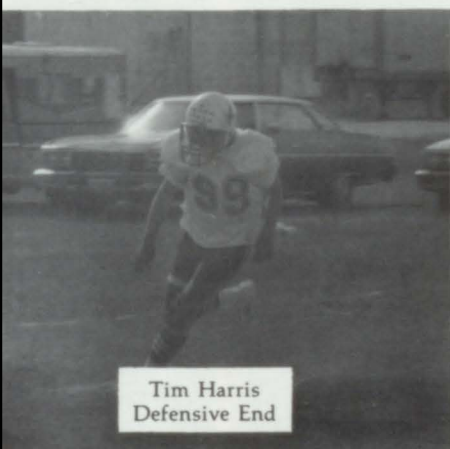

Kindal Barnes recieved the Eastman Kodak Company Award at the State Fair.

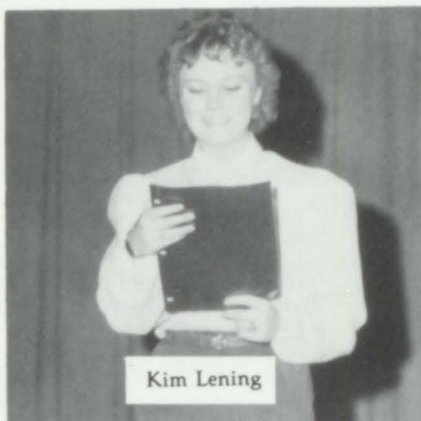

The PJH Football team was very young this year. The boys played only two games for the season. There were seven boys out for the sport, leaving the team with only one substitute.

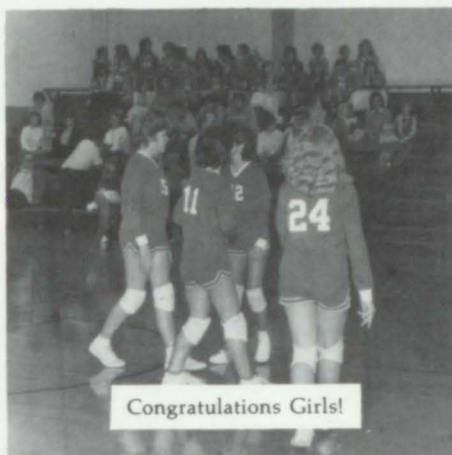
The boys started off the season in a difficult game with Weskan that ended in a loss 47-21. The Hawk team took their second loss to a tough Kit Carson team 47-19.

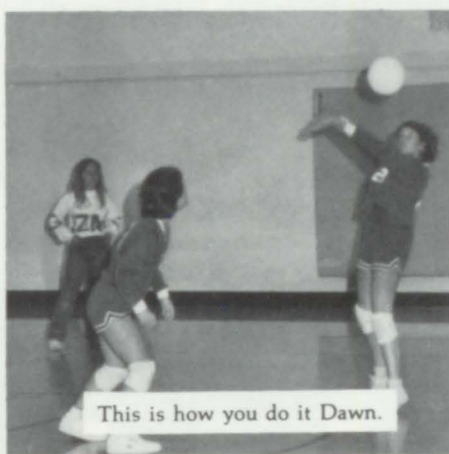

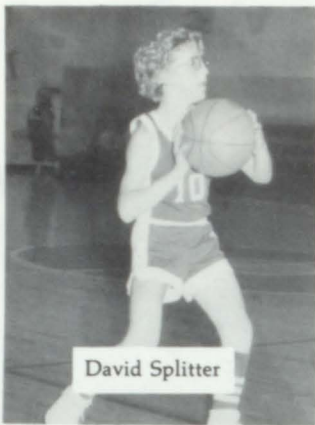
Girls Take Consolation
