
A real positive was the three game win streak at the end of the season. Individuals on the team showed a willingness to be shifted to different positions which made us a better football team.



#### COACH'S COMMENT

The injury to Meg Kreutzer sent the team into a tail-spin going 2 and 5 through the Swink Tournament, finishing a dissappointing 4th at the invite.

However, this situation allowed Kristi B., Melissa, and Rachel to gain valuable experience which toughened the team for the important post season tournaments.

The team came together in districts, playing their best ball so far against Cheraw. Five of six starters turned in season best performances at that match. An emotional let-down followed, resulting in a loss to Hugo in the

finals. Revenge was sweet. One week later all six starters improved their season-best perfomances in defeating Hugo at the regional playoffs. It was satisfying to me as a coach to see the hard work pay off for the girls.

I'd like to say congratulations to all of them, Special congratulations to Cari, Amy and Meg, for their new records, to Melissa for her vast improvement, to Kristi Larrew for gaining confidence in her serve (without which we'd never have gotten past districts) and to Kristi Baxter and Rachel Zimmerman for handling the heat with such grace when Meg and Kristi L. were hurt. And finally to Stephanie for serving 95% through the State Tournament and finishing her career with her personal best performance.










#### COACH'S COMMENTS




