#### COACH'S COMMENT

The 1990 Volleyball season was nothing if not exciting. The season began with two losses but heading into the 4th week of the season, the Eagles had established a 4-2 record. The injury to Meg Kreutzer sent the team into a tail-spin going 2 and 5 through the Swink Tournament, finishing a disappointing 4th at the invite.

However, this situation allowed Kristi B., Melissa, and Rachel to gain valuable experience which toughened the team for the important post season tournaments.

The team came together in districts, playing their best ball so far against Cheraw. Five of six starters turned in season best performances at that match. An emotional let-down followed, resulting in a loss to Hugo in the finals. Revenge was sweet. And finally to Stephanie for serving 95% through the State Tournament and finishing her career with her personal best performance.

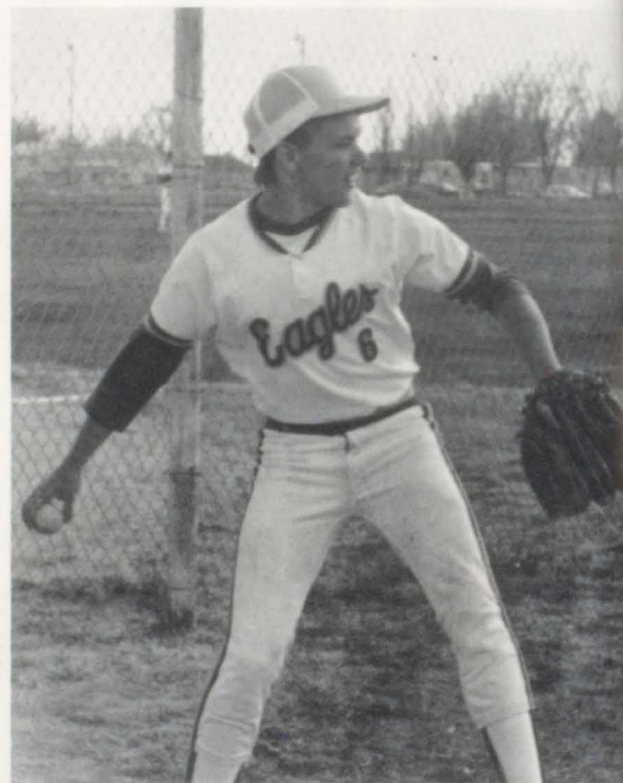
