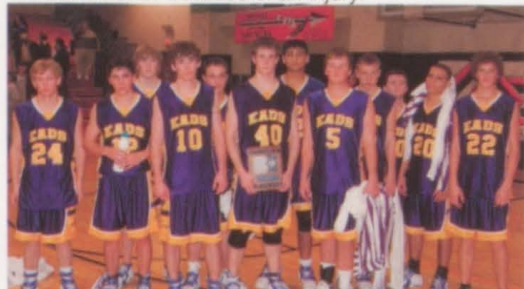




# E A D S B A S K E T B A L L
