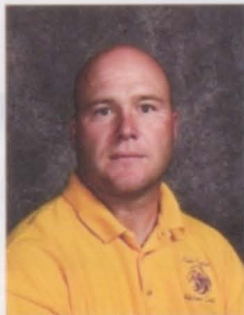
THIS PAST SCHOOL YEAR was amazing. I feel so lucky and privileged to have been a part of the wonderful accomplishments and successes the students and staff at Eads High School enjoyed. Academically, we maintained our HIGH rating at the state level and became the first school in Colorado to implement the 1-to-1 Laptop Project that allows our students to access information and produce outstanding papers and projects with their own computer. The clubs and organizations saw top-notch results with FFA and FBLA coming home with the most awards these groups have ever produced in their individual histories. We had four maverick FBLA students who became the first in Eads High School history to qualify for FBLA Nationals in Chicago, and our FFA state CDE results included the most GOLD we have ever brought home from that prestigious competition. We saw such organizations as NHS, STAND, and STUCO raise their standards of excellence and become more effective in their specific missions. The fine arts were well-represented through two drama productions, art shows, and concerts. The achievements in the sports arena were also unprecedented for our school as we enjoyed quite a maiden 6-man football season getting to the state championship and becoming state runner-up in our first season in the division. Our Eads Lady Eagles basketball team won their eighth gold ball thus breaking Colorado's record for the most basketball titles, girls or boys, in any division. We had four wrestlers make it to a very tough 2A state tournament where two placed in the final four in their individual weight divisions. Finally, the spring came in fast and furious and our baseball team is enjoying top-level dominance in the newly established 1A division in Colorado baseball. All in all, it has been quite a memorable year at Eads High School and I challenge next year's student body to "Top That" because there are still areas where improvement can come. "Think little goals and expect little achievements. Think big goals and win big success."

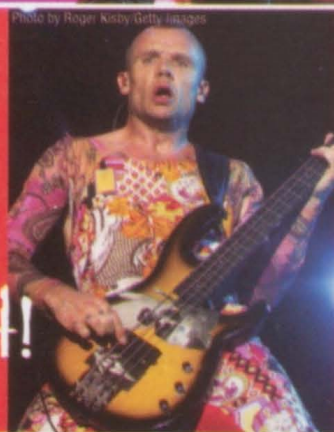

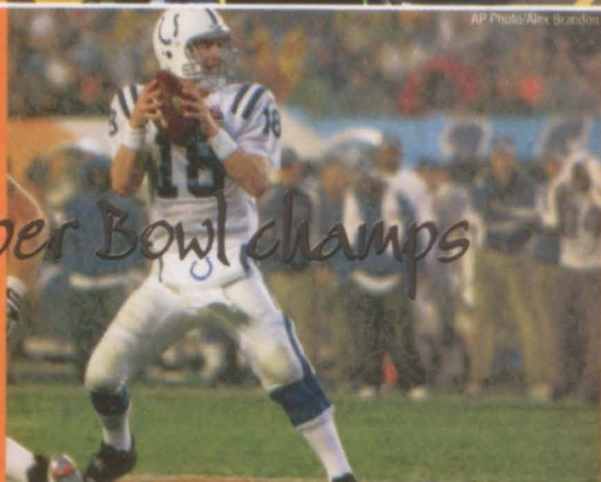

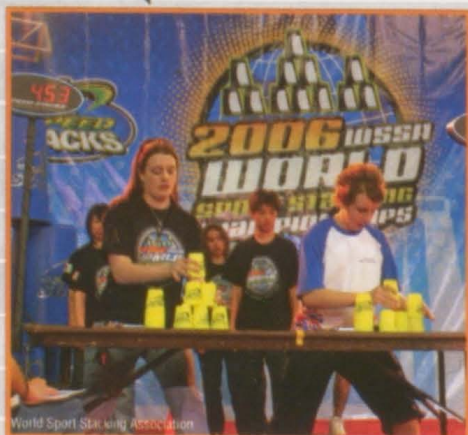

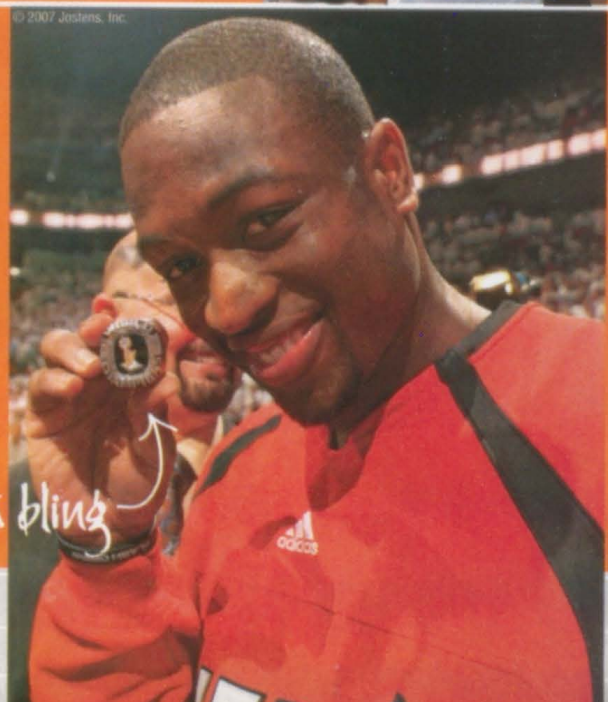

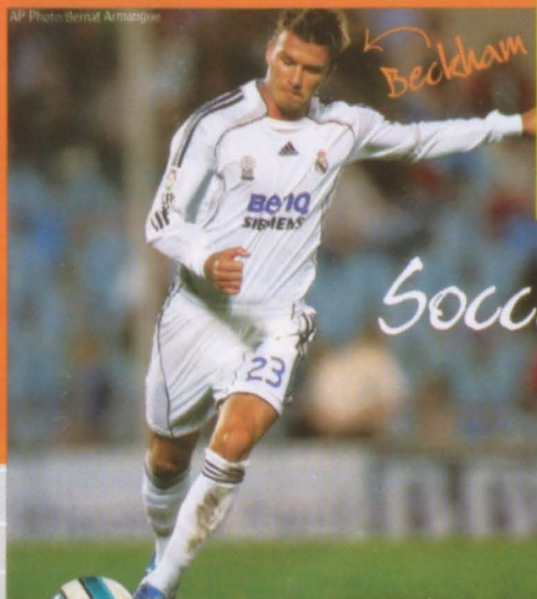

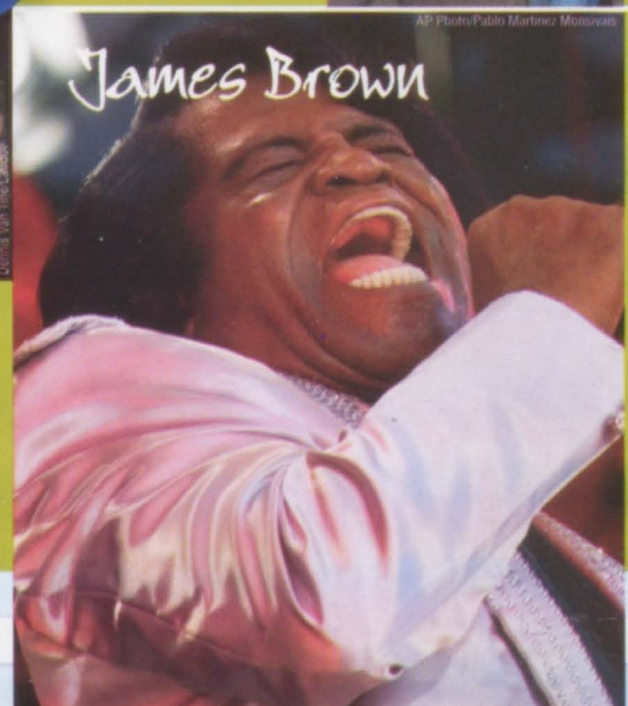
