# Mitchell Tragedy

On the Thursday of October 13, 2011, the Mitchell family van crashed into the back end of a semi truck on Highway 287. The van was on its way to Eads to drop off the kids to school. There were 12 students and children in the van with Howard Mitchell driving. During the ride to Eads, the van unexpectedly smashed into a semi stopped at a construction site. This crash happened at approximately 7:30 in the morning.

Unfortunately there were 6 casualties including Howard Mitchell (57), Tony Mitchell (10), Tayla Mitchell (10), Austyn Atkinson (11), Andy Dawson (13), and Jeremy Franks (17). The funeral for these 6 loved ones was on October 21, and was held at the Eads High School gym. Hundreds of people gathered to commemorate the lives that were lost that beautiful October day.

Howard Mitchell was a loyal and loving man. He was the faithful husband of his best friend Melody Mitchell, the father of many, and a grandpa. He never had a doubt about his faith and with it, he was able to touch so many lives.

Tony Mitchell had bright, young soul. He never knew a stranger and always welcomed people with giant hugs. His smile was infectious, and was often in trouble for being an "over-lover." He loved to show his love and happiness, and everyone who knew him, got touched by it.

Tayla Mitchell (the princess) was the only girl among the 10 boys at the Mitchell house. She was a girly-girl, loved pink, and could always be found singing to her CD's of Taylor Swift or her Christian Children's CD's. Her big smile and big, brown eyes could light up the darkest moments. With those secret weapons, she was able to get her big, tough brothers to do whatever she wanted.

Austyn Atkinson was loving and caring. He had a bright personality, and was always there to cheer people up. He loved making sure everyone was happy and comfortable before himself, like he did every Sunday in church. Austyn also had a real passion for cooking, and loved helping with anything in the kitchen.

Andy Dawson was born in the city, but found that his heart was set in the country. He started wearing cowboy boots, and loved helping his older brothers with the horses. You could find a giant grin on his face every time he talked about his belt buckle he won at Rodeo Bible Camp. From this experience, he knew that he wanted to become a Cowboy Preacher. He was also a giant Oklahoma Sooners fan, and dreamt to be a part of that team one day.

Jeremy Franks loved the animals at the Mitchell's house. He loved spending time with the dogs and each newly born litter of puppies. He was so kind and generous to the little children. He was often found giving them rides on his back, and always wore a giant smile as he did so. He was also a new Christian and was so proud to be a part of mission trip to Guatemala. The people that we lost made great impacts on everyone's lives that got the opportunity to know them. They will be greatly missed, but will never be forgotten; they were too special of people.

We are very fortunate to have many survivors that were treated for their various injuries at hospitals throughout Denver and Cheyenne Wells. Robert Miller, Scott Fua, TJ Mitchell, Daniel Ortega, Brandon Rollins, Beau McMillen, and William Palmer were among the survivors of this deadly crash. All have been released from the various hospitals except TJ Mitchell. He is out of the hospital, and is now located at the rehab center across from the hospital he stayed at in Denver. We are glad to have these people home, and will never forget the imprinted memories of the ones we lost.

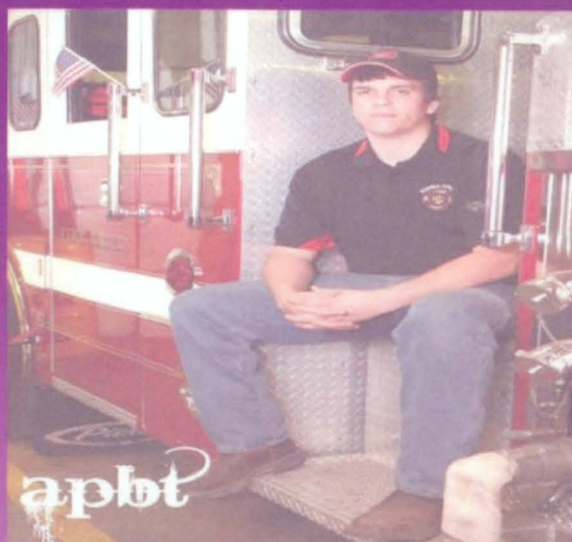

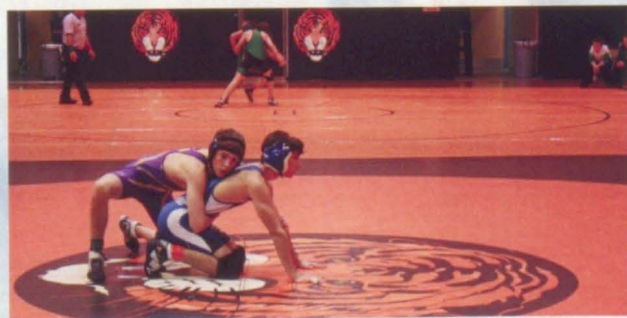
